## **Case Victory**

Trevor Resurreccion and John Grijalva recently prevailed on a Motion for Summary Judgment against a plaintiff on the grounds that the plaintiff had no legally valid assignment of claims and, therefore, was barred from pursuing any claims against the defendant. The case, which involved a dispute between two former business partners, was venued in the Orange County Superior Court.
